Sub: Conduct of University End Semester ONLINE Examinations JUNE 2021.

It is hereby notified that the Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes of Centre for Distance Education and Virtual Learning, University End Semester ONLINE examinations of MA, M.Sc., M.Com., PG Diploma and BA, B.Com, BBA, B.Sc., BCA will be held during June 2021. The detailed time table is enclosed herewith.

In view of the emerging situation related to COVID-19, pandemic it is important to ensure everybody's safety and wellbeing. Thus the examination will be held ONLINE mode and all the eligible students who have paid the required fees and whose admissions have been approved by the University are permitted to take up the examination (this time only) irrespective of their assignments submission. However the result of those students who have not submitted their assignments will be withheld and will be released once they submit their assignments and score minimum 40% marks in it.

The Pattern of the Question Paper is as follows:

There is maximum 70 marks Paper and the duration is 02 hours and 30 minutes. Approximately equal number of questions has been drawn from each module.

- a) 50 marks are allotted for Multiple Choice Questions with 4 optional answers. Total number of questions is 50, each question carries 01 mark.
- b) 20 marks are allotted for the questions of descriptive answers with the following descriptions:
 1. Short Answer Questions for 10 Marks - Students need to answer 05 questions out of 07 questions, each question carries 02 Marks.
 2. Long Answer Questions for 10 Marks - Students need to answer 02 questions out of 03 questions, each question carries 05 marks.

The following examination fees are applicable only for repeaters appearing for the examinations.
